Windows Disk Protection tracks changes that users or programs make to the hard disk (including changes made by viruses or spyware). Each time the computer restarts, changes are discarded and the hard disk is reset to its original state. Windows Disk Protection also lets administrators schedule the automatic application of Microsoft Critical updates, antivirus signatures and other updates they wish to permanently save.

The *User Restrictions* tool makes it easy for administrators to control what users are permitted to do on a shared computer. Administrators can set sessions timers, control access to every drive on the computer, set the home page and enforce an extensive list of policy restrictions. These restrictions limit a user's ability to change desktop settings or access system utilities such as Control Panel, the command prompt and Registry Editor. By checking a box, administrators can also restrict users from running unauthorized software on a shared computer, even from the Internet or an external device.

The User Restrictions tool helps to:

- Prevent the unauthorized use of system utilities
- Prohibit access to important data
- Simplify the Start menu

The Toolkit will help administrators create a simple and consistent desktop experience for end users. It will also help to protect end user privacy with a new privacy feature that clears session information including Web passwords, Internet History and recently used documents each time a new user logs in. Additionally, the *Accessibility* tool consolidates several Windows accessibility features into one interface so that users can find them more easily and rapidly re-create a particular accessibility configuration.

- View and control accessibility features from one place
- Easily enable or disable desired accessibility features
