Abstract

With Microsoft® Windows VistaTM, Microsoft introduces a new color management infrastructure designed to foster innovation over then next decade. The Windows Color System (WCS) establishes a new "smart CMM/simple profile" CMS model with a transparent, modular, and extensible architecture. WCS provides native support for high dynamic range, wide gamut, high bit-depth ("high, wide,

and deep") color. WCS also provides continuing, enhanced support for ICC-based color management, providing seamless interoperability between ICC and WCS profiles and transforms.
